**2019 CALIFORNIA MODEL CODES ADOPTED AND IN
EFFECT ON JANUARY 1, 2020 FOR THE CITY OF ADELANTO**

On July 1, 2019 The State of California Adopted the 2019 California Building, Residential, Historic, Existing, Mechanical, Electrical, Plumbing, Fire, Energy, Green, Administrative and Referenced Standard Codes. These codes become effective in the City Of Adelanto on January 1, 2020.

What this means to you.

All Plans submitted for Plan Review on or after January 1, 2020 will have to comply with the 2019 Versions of the California Building, Residential, Historic, Existing, Mechanical, Electrical, Plumbing, Fire, Energy, Green, Administrative and Referenced Standard Codes and with the City of Adelanto adopted Code of Ordinances.

Any plan review that was submitted prior to January 1, 2020 can still comply with with the 2016 Versions of the California Codes only if the 180-day plan review time frame has not expired. All Tract developments that have NOT paid for and taken out permit Prior to the January 1, 2020 deadline, for all their remaining house plans, must re-submit for a new Plan review and will have to comply with the 2019 California Adopted Codes and **new Plan Review Fees will have to be paid upon submittal.**
